



Battery cannot be charged after new system

Charging the laptop battery outside the operating system (when the laptop is powered off) helps isolate hardware-related issues. Turn off the computer. Try one of the ...

1) Check the Lenovo Vantage app. It will tell you battery condition. It also allows what is called a "threshold". If the battery reaches this threshold (i.e. 75%), the battery will stop charging and display "plugged in and not charging". 2) If that didn't pan out, turn off the laptop, unplug the... - Lenovo Thinkpad T430

2. Power Adapter. It is possible that the power adapter is loose. Duh. In case you have already checked, maybe the power adapter is simply not working which means the battery is not getting charged.

Check the battery: If your vehicle is older or has halogen headlights try turning on the car's headlights and check if they are bright. If they are dim or not working, the battery may be weak or dead. Use a multimeter to test the battery voltage. A fully charged battery should read around 12.6 volts.
