It is normal. Heating up depends on the losses. Charging with 100A generates roughly 10W losses per cell in pretty good battery build scenario. So these are 40W heating up your battery. This is just an example, but it gives the idea about what should you expect. Same goes for discharging. It will also heat up the battery.

Red /Orange Light: During the charging process, a red/orange light means the battery is still charging and isn't fully topped up yet. Follow the 80-20 % rule. This means charging the battery to approximately 80-90% capacity and recharging it when it drops to around 20-30%.
