Equatorial Guinea's real GDP growth has been weak in recent years, averaging -0.5% per year from 2010 to 2014, because of a declining hydrocarbon sector. Inflation remained very low in 2016, down from an average of 4% in 2014. As a middle income country

Equatorial Guinea had a population of 790,000 people in 2013 (IEA, 2016). Total electricity production in 2015 was 82 ktoe with 57.3 per cent generated from hydro and 41.4 per cent generated from fossil fuels (IEA, 2016). Electricity consumption in 2015 was 36 ktoe.
