

This manual describes how to install the Series 685 or Series 1085 Battery Cabinet (see Figure 1). It contains instructions for unpacking and inspecting the battery cabinet, locating the battery ...

First, install the (+) positive red terminal clamp on the (+) positive battery post. Push it all the way down so the battery post sticks up past the top of the cable clamp, and tighten the nut snugly. Next, install the (-) ...

Install a new battery. Make sure you replace it with the same battery type as the old one. Make sure the new battery is tightly held in place. The most common CMOS battery type is a CR2032 battery which can be ...

One cabinet should be able to hold at least one complete string of cells. Best practice is that strings should not be split between two cabinets in order to ensure reliability of the entire string. Figure 1 - Battery cabinet with top terminal cells. A battery disconnect switch should be located as closely as possible to the end of a string.

To change the code, follow the Changing the User Code steps on page 9. The cabinet needs a 240V mains electrical supply to run the thermostat, heater and lighting; this is estimated at a few pounds per year. The premises owner should be informed of this cost when the placement of the cabinet is being evaluated. AEDs have consumable components that will need replacing periodically or when they have been used.
