The motherboard battery, also known as the CMOS battery, is a small round battery that powers the BIOS (Basic Input/Output System) of your computer. The BIOS is the software that controls the initial boot-up process of your computer, and it stores important information about your computer's hardware configuration.

Replace the battery with the exact same type of coin cell battery. Dell desktops use CR2032 coin cell battery (see the markings on the battery). See the documentation of your Dell desktop for model-specific information. Removing the CMOS battery erases the BIOS settings; Ensure to replace with a brand new battery. Do not install a used battery.

Press the power button for a minimum of 60 seconds to drain all power from the computer and reset the CMOS values on the system board. Reinstall the CMOS battery, and then reassemble the computer. Reconnect the AC adapter to the computer. Press and hold the power button for 20 seconds. Release the power button and the system boots.

For larger motherboards that have a separate slot for the CMOS battery, follow these steps to remove the CMOS. 1- Remove the CMOS battery by pressing the lock on the CMOS battery slot on the motherboard. 2- The battery will easily pop out once you push it to the side. If you have trouble using the lock, using a small thin pin to remove the CMOS ...

The motherboard, also known as a system board or mainboard, is the primary printed circuit board (PCB) in a computer that enables communication between the internal components. Diagnosing a faulty motherboard is tricky since the symptoms are similar to other failing components.

Depending on the brand of the circuit on your motherboard, you can easily remove the upper part of the NVRAM - which is a rectangular plastic cover - using a small screwdriver.

To replace the CMOS battery on an ASUS motherboard, you will need to first locate the CMOS battery on the motherboard, then gently remove it, insert the new battery, and finally, reset the BIOS settings if necessary.
