You can quickly remove the plastic cover from a car battery with a flat tool. Just remove any fasteners or clips holding the cover in place, then lift the cover off. Remember to replace the cover when you're done, as it is ...

Detach the negative (black) battery cable from the battery. First loosen the nut with a combination wrench. A better tool to use would be battery pliers or a battery wrench.

Locate the battery latches. The battery latch mechanism can be compared to a door -- The right latch, when pushed right, unlocks the battery, while the left latch, when pushed ...

Those should work but without attaching the retaining ring to the battery, they will tend to get lost. You could attach the ring to the battery connector but on my battery, it means removing the battery case and un soldering the connector. The caps I linked above get lost as well but they are so cheap, I just keep a supply in my bike bag.
