I have been using an Anker PowerCore 20000 for a while now. This works with most devices, can charge an iPhone over 5 times, and is allowed in your carry-on bag. With your airline's approval, you can take devices that contain larger lithium-ion batteries (101-160 watt-hours per battery).

Several courier companies worldwide allow shippers to send lithium batteries overseas if the items are within their guidelines and regulations. However, some couriers may charge additional fees for handling these items, ...

Each cell or battery must be under a certain power capacity rating: Each Lithium-ion cell - maximum 20 Watt-hours. Each Lithium-ion battery - maximum 100 Watt-hours. (Batteries for most consumer devices are likely to be under this limit eg. mobile phones, laptops, tablet computers, cameras etc.

It's easy to ship batteries with ParcelBroker but there are a few restrictions to remember: Lithium batteries must be contained within electrical equipment, like inside a laptop. No more than two batteries (or four cells) are allowed per package, and no more than two packages per consignment. The batteries cannot exceed 5kg in weight per package.

Zinc-Carbon batteries do not currently come in a rechargeable variant, although there is no physical reason why they could not be recharged. Like Alkaline batteries, applying a charging current to them will reverse the reaction, but since they are not designed to be recharged, may explode from pressure.

Eneloop batteries are not alkaline batteries but rather nickel-metal hydride with a nominal voltage of 1.2V and only drop of to about 1.0V when discharged. This will cause devices that report the remaining battery life of alkaline batteries to misreport the Eneloop batteries as always low on charge.
